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SCHOLARSHIPS POLICY

OASIS SCHOLARSHIP

The Scholarship initiated by Backward Classes Welfare Department of West Bengal, provides financial aid to the students from SC, ST and OBC categories to pursue their education. The scholarship is State Govt. funded and dedicated to the persons with West Bengal Domiciles.

Objectives

To provide financial assistance to underprivileged students from West Bengal for their education.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a permanent resident of West Bengal.
- Belong to SC/ST/OBC category.
- Must be studying in a recognized post-secondary institution.
- Family income should not exceed ₹2,50,000 per annum for SC/ST and ₹1,00,000 per annum for OBC.


Benefits

- Tuition fees reimbursement.
- Maintenance allowance.
- $\circ~$ Ad-hoc grant for books, stationery, and other educational materials.
- Additional benefits for students with disabilities.
- Post-matric scholarship for SC/ST students for general courses up to graduate level- INR 300 per month.

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Aikyashree Scholarship

The Aikyashree Scholarship is a prominent initiative by the Government of West Bengal aimed at supporting the education of students belonging to minority communities.

Objectives

The Aikyashree Scholarship program is designed to provide financial assistance to meritorious and economically disadvantaged students from minority communities, including Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, Sikhs, Parsis, and Jains. The primary goal is to encourage higher education and reduce dropout rates among these communities.

Types of Aikyashree Scholarship

- Post-Matric Scholarship: For students after XII
- Talent Support Stipend (TSP): For students who have passed their last examination with less than 50% marks
- Swami Vivekananda Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (SVMCM): For meritorious students more than 60% marks

Eligibility Criteria for Post-Matric

- Applicant must be domicile of West Bengal
- Must secure 50% or equivalent marks in previous academic qualification
- Total Income must be less than 2,00,000 pa.

Eligibility Criteria for SVMCM

- Applicant must be domicile of West Bengal
- Must secure 60% or equivalent marks in previous academic qualification
- Must have the previous qualification from West Bengal State Board/Council of Secondary/Higher Secondary and Madrasah Education and State University
- Total Income must be less than 2,50,000 pa.



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Swami Vivekananda Merit Cum Means Scholarship

The Swami Vivekananda Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (SVMCM) is a prestigious scholarship initiative by the Government of West Bengal, designed to support meritorious students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds in pursuing higher education.

Objectives

To assist the meritorious students belonging to economically backward families in the State of West Bengal to pursue higher studies, in West Bengal.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be residents of West Bengal.
- Students must have scored at least 60% (75% for 2020 or earlier pass out candidates) marks in the Higher Secondary examination (12th standard) conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent.
- The annual family income of the applicant's family should not exceed INR 2.5 lakhs.


Benefits

• Undergraduate Level: INR 1,000 per month



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Kanyashree Prakalpa

Kanyashree Prakalpa is a flagship scheme launched by the Government of West Bengal aimed at improving the status and well-being of girls, particularly from socio-economically disadvantaged families, through conditional cash transfers.

Objectives

- Discouraging child marriage by providing financial incentives for girls to stay in school.
- $\circ~$ Encourage education among girls by providing financial support for schooling and higher education.
- Promote the empowerment of girls by ensuring they have the opportunity to pursue education and vocational training.

Types of schemes

- K1 Scheme: An annual scholarship for unmarried girls aged 13 to 18 years, studying in classes VIII to XII, or equivalent.
- K2 Scheme: A one-time grant for unmarried girls aged 18 to 19 years, who are enrolled in academic or vocational courses.

Eligibility

For K1 Scheme:

- Age: Girls aged 13 to 18 years.
- Education: Must be enrolled in classes VIII to XII or equivalent.
- Marital Status: Must be unmarried.
- Family Income: Annual family income should not exceed INR 1,20,000

For K2 Scheme:

- Age: Girls aged 18 to 19 years.
- Education: Must be enrolled in an educational institution or vocational training center.
- Marital Status: Must be unmarried.

Benefits

- K1 Scheme: INR 750 per year
- One-Time Grant (K2 Level)- INR 25,000



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
