2. Objectives of the Practice

The primary objective of the practice is to empower the female students who come from rural and marginal areas of Kultali, by providing rigorous academic, administrative, psychological, health related, financial and social support. Further, the college aims to promote equality by encouraging rural women students in higher education and by paying special attention to their needs in order to meet their individual as well as social growth. The aim is to establish a safe and inclusive campus environment free from discrimination and harassment. By focusing on these objectives Kultali Dr. B.R Ambedkar College aims to create an environment that empowers female students, reduces dropout rates, and ensures that women have equal opportunities to succeed and thrive in their academic and professional lives.

3. The Context

Kultali Dr. B. R. Ambedkar College is situated in the in the remote and ecologically sensitive Sundarbans area of South 24 Parganas District, a region facing significant ecological and environmental challenges due to its remote and sensitive ecosystem. The area is characterized by high population density, limited access to resources, and vulnerability. The College is also situated in a vulnerable socio – economic background where various social ills persist with rates of high early marriage for female students accompanied by increased drop out rates. There has been a tendency among the parents due to the social background and rural mindset to neglect and compromise on the higher education requirements of their girl child. Mental and physical health of girl students also got neglected which came as a concern to college administration. Realising the seriousness of the situation, the college designed – "Swa Sakti – Nari Sakti" an umbrella of initiatives under this practice to ensure empowerment of women in this area.

4. The Practice

The college designed – "Swa Sakti – Nari Sakti" an umbrella of initiatives under this practice to ensure empowerment of women in this area as their best practise:



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- Enhancing Access and Enrolment Drives: The College has taken comprehensive initiatives to increase enrolment through various programs, drives and have addressed societal and cultural barriers that prevent girls from pursuing higher education.
 - **Personality Development programs: The College has** Implemented retention programs, mentorship, and counselling services to support female students throughout their academic journey through various support initiatives. The College with special focus on female students has Offered career counselling, skills development workshops, and extracurricular activities to foster personal and professional growth.
- **Creating a Supportive Environment**: The College has taken all means to establish a safe and inclusive campus environment free from discrimination and harassment (through 24 x 7 CCTV Surveillance, ICC, Anti Ragging Cell, Policy Against Sexual Harassment, speedy redressals). The College had tried to provide flexible class schedules to accommodate the needs of female students.
 - **Obliterating Gender Bias and Stereotypes**: The College has Conducted workshops and awareness programs to challenge gender stereotypes and promote gender equality.
 - **Promoting Health and Well-being**: For the past five years and above, the college has tailored health camps which include health services, including mental health support, suitable to the needs of female students and have promoted programs to raise awareness about health issues that disproportionately affect women and promote healthy lifestyle choices. Concrete initiatives on the part of the college are taken to enhance the nutritional status of Female Students.
 - **Strengthening Economic Independence**: The College on various occasions have Provided financial literacy training to help women manage their finances and plan for the future and have extended administrative help to carry forward their higher studies and have arranged for programs to display their creative propensity.
 - Encouraging Community Engagement and Advocacy: The College has involved female students in community service and advocacy projects that promote women's rights and empowerment. The College has built partnerships with organizations that support women's education and empowerment initiatives.

5. Evidence of Success: The success of the "Swa Sakti – Nari Sakti is evident through various metrics and achievements:

• Due to the success of various gender sensitisation programs and women empowerment-based initiatives like seminars, workshops centred solely around women have been organised with the close cooperation of IQAC, Women Cell, Internal Complaints Committee Anti Ragging Cell and Grievance Redressal Cell the college has registered evidence reduction of dropout rates within the

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female students. These awareness programs have helped our girls' students to realise their full potential for learning and solving their own problems independently

- It has been witnessed due to the various counselling and personality development programmes there has been a registered increase of female students during the time of admission and also a earmarked achievements in the higher education field on the part of the female students in various aspects.
- There has been an evident increase in the number of toppers in various departments among the female students.
- The evidence number of hill camps arranged and tailored for the purpose of the female students have benefited them immensely in terms of health hygiene and female sanitation. Programmes in collaboration with the State Government, UNICEF and the BMOH, Adolescent Counsellor of the local area has helped me very fruitful.
- The awareness campaigns in workshops especially focussing on scholarships and with special preference to female students have aided them in reducing financial barriers to education.
- The college is also conducted gender Audit, Which views is testimony to the women empowerment initiatives taken on the part of the government and its success rate.
- Since the college propagates, "Swa Sakti Nari Sakti" as its best practise it has also dedicated a volume of its Yearly Edited Book Volume Rethinking 21 St Century on Women Empowerment.
- Various initiatives under the umbrella programme "Swa Sakti Nari Sakti" has also registered a clear increase in the participation of female students in various institutional programmes cultural programmes and practises

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required

Kultali Dr. B. R. Ambedkar College is located in the Sundarbans area and thereby faces unique challenges in propagating initiatives on women empowerment due to the region's specific socio-economic, geographic, and cultural conditions

- The environmental vulnerability of the location of the college hinders an open-ended access to the college to adopt various initiatives at various occasions. The Sundarbans are prone to natural disasters like cyclones and flooding, which can disrupt educational activities and infrastructure.
- Due to its remote accessibility and vulnerability, electricity, and internet connectivity, many a times hinders promotional and awareness-based activities.
- High levels of poverty prevent families from affording education.





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- Since the Government Aided Colleges have to solely depend upon the State Government for mobilisation of funds many attend financial constraints also happen to be a major obstacle towards this end, especially in a socioeconomically weak area like Kultali in the Sundarbans area.
- Traditional gender roles and societal expectations may discourage women from pursuing higher education and empowerment initiatives.

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


