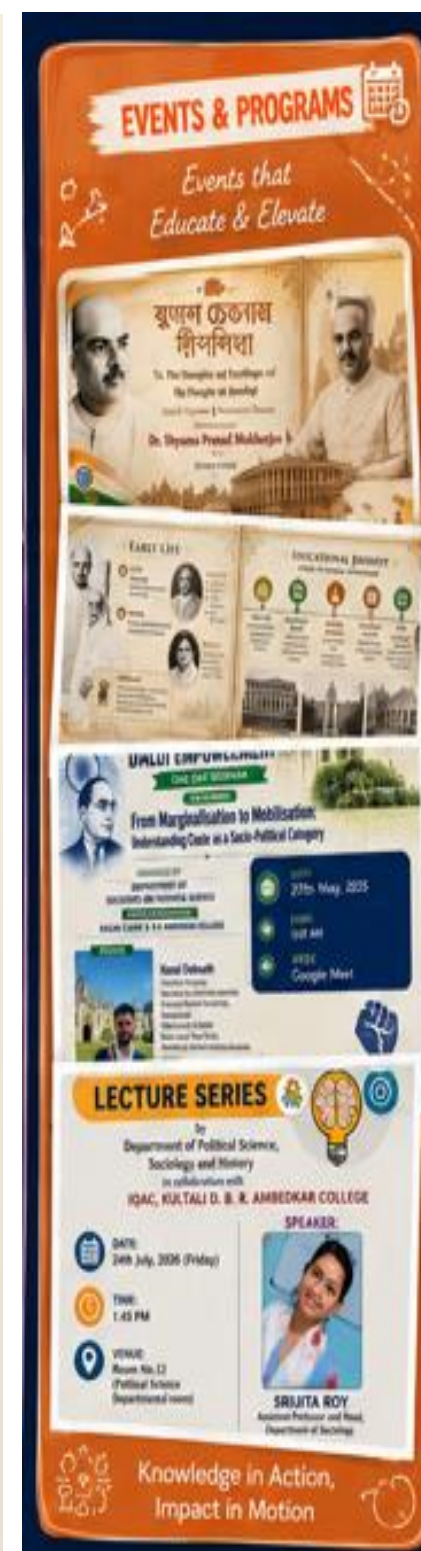

Academic Framework

Initially following the **Part-Based System**, the department transitioned to the **Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)** in the 2018-19 academic session, keeping pace with modern educational reforms. It presently operates under two parallel frameworks – CBCS and the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**, introducing a four-year Curriculum Credit Framework alongside the three-year Multidisciplinary Course (MDC). The curriculum emphasizes skill enhancement through tutorial presentations, fostering critical thinking and depth of understanding.
