ETYMOLOGICAL CONCEPT OF EDUCATION

- The Word EDUCATION is derived from Latin word EDUCERE, EDUCARE and EDUCATUM which means “to learn” “to know” and “to lead out”
- That is education means to lead out internal hidden talent of a child or person.

Etymological terms	Meaning	
1.Educare	To bring up, to nourish	
2.Educere	To lead out or to draw out	
3.Educo	‘E’ means out and ‘Duco’ means to lead	
4.Educatum	The act of teaching or training	



INDIAN CONCEPT OF EDUCATION

- ***Rig Veda***: ‘Education is that which makes a man self –reliant and selfless.’
- ***Upanishads***: ‘ Education is that whose end product is salvation’.
- ***Swami Vivekananda***: ‘Education is the manifestation of divine perfection, already in man’.
- ***Gandhi’s***: ‘ By education I mean all round drawing out of the best in child and man- body , mind and spirit.’
- ***Zakir Hussain***: ‘Education is the work of the whole life. It begins from the time of birth and continues till last moment of death.’



WESTERN CONCEPT OF EDUCATION

- Plato: Education develops in the body and soul of the pupil all the beauty and all the perfection he is capable of.'
- Rousseau: Education is the child's development from within .
- Froebel: Education is enfoldment of what is already enfolded in the germ. It is the process through which the child makes the internal external.'
- Pestalazzi: 'Education is the harmonious and progressive development of all the innate powers and faculties of man-physical, intellectual and moral.'

NARROW MEANING OF EDUCATION

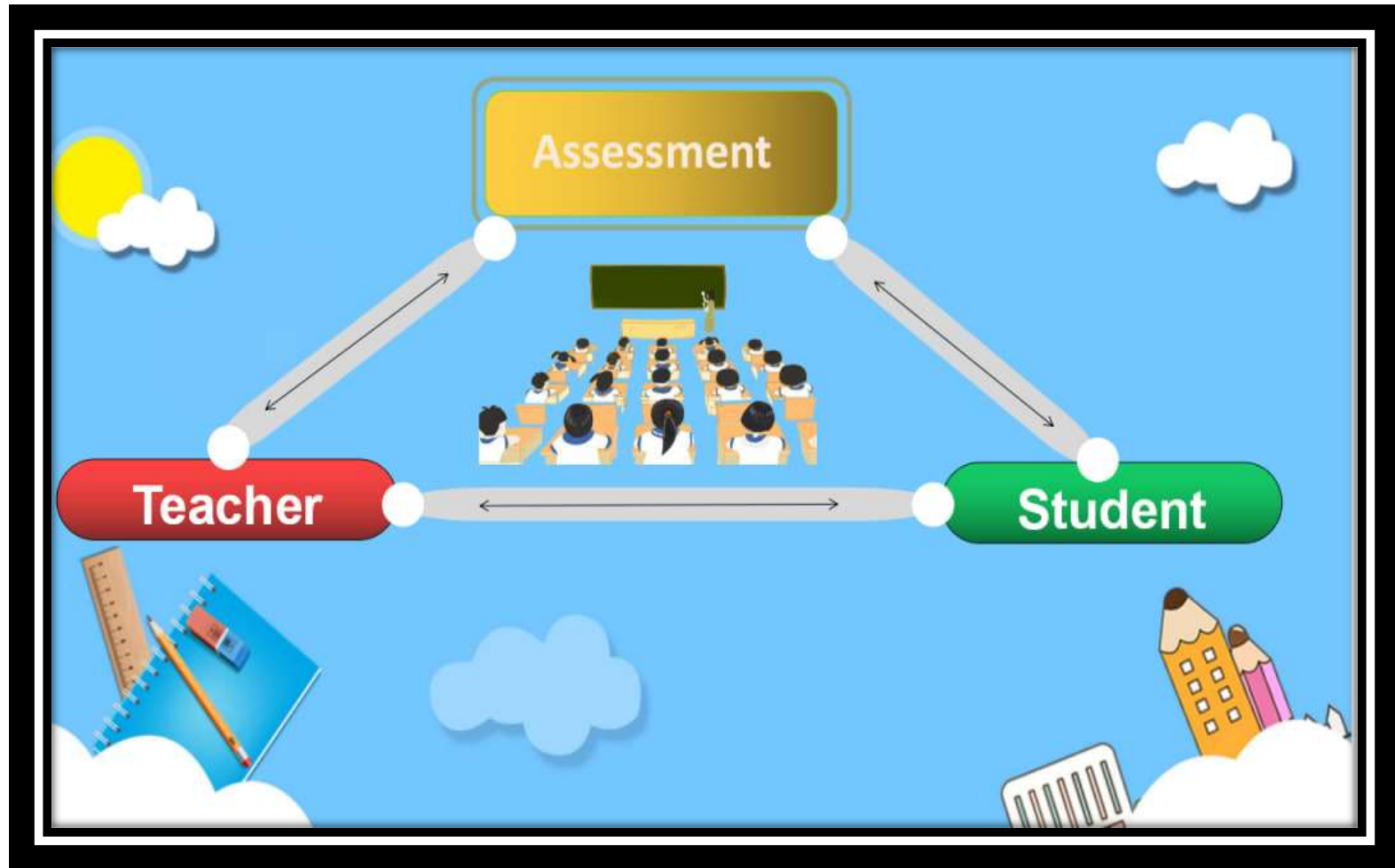
- Education limited under the premises of educational institutions

BROADER CONCEPT OF EDUCATION



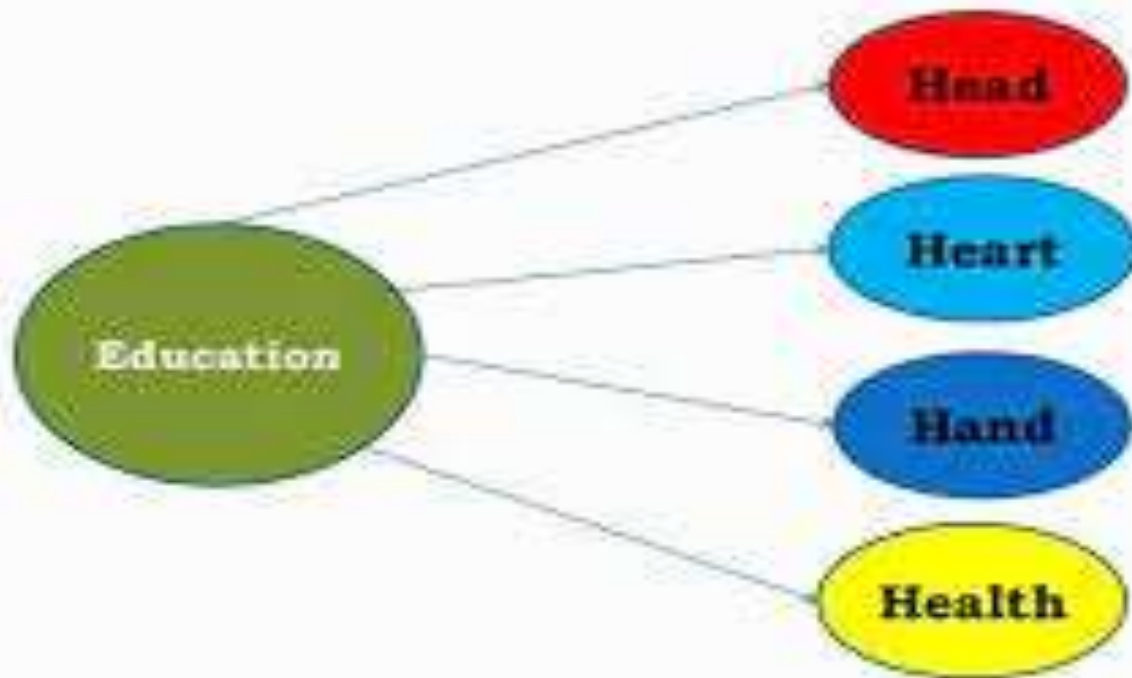
BROADER MEANING OF EDUCATION

- It starts from cradle and ends to the grave

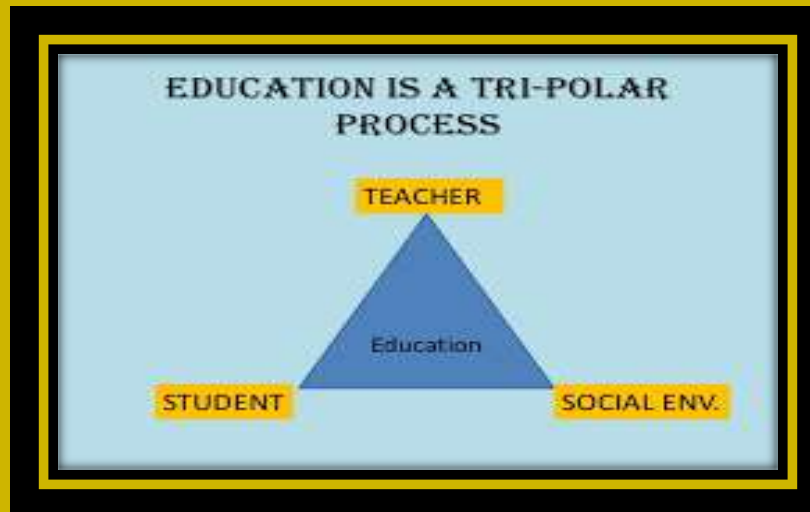




Modern concept of Education
