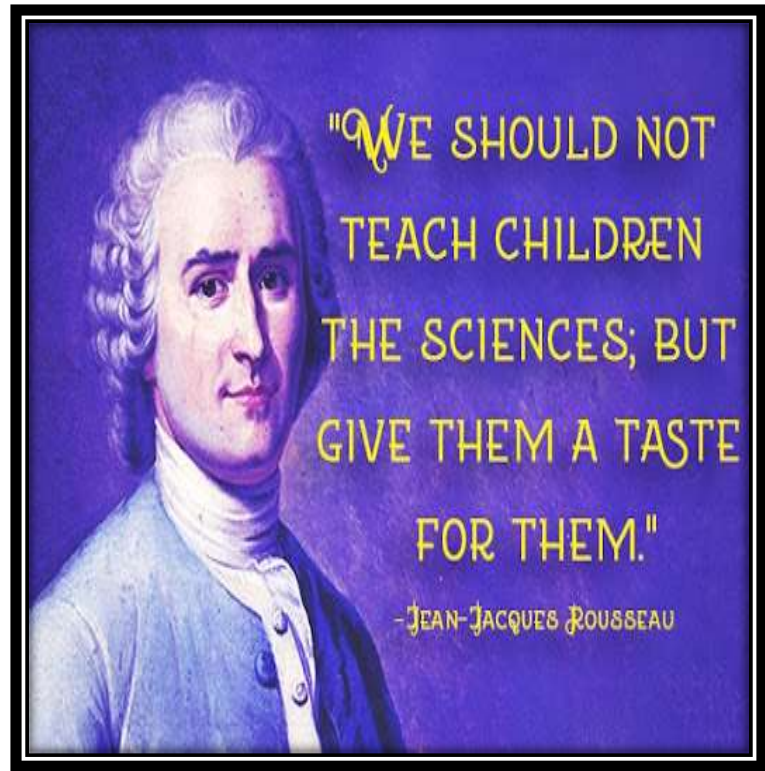

- ❖ From cradle to grave



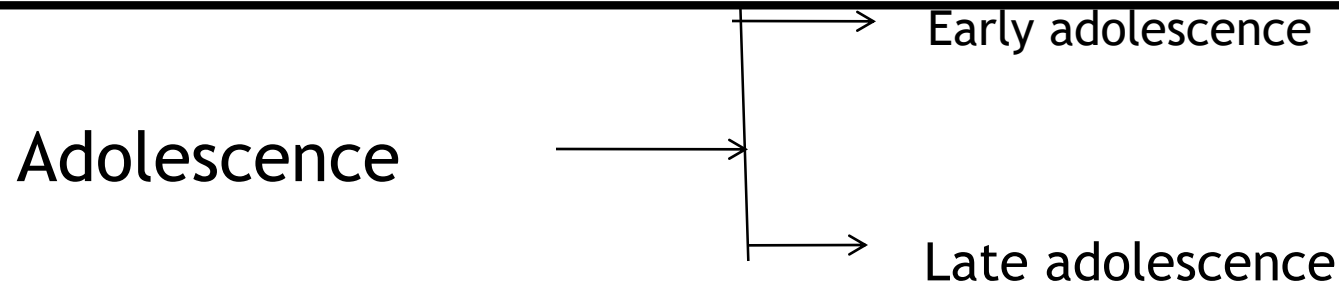
AIMS OF EDUCATION AT DIFFERENT STAGES
